

PAID PARKING INFORMATION

CITY OF NEWBURYPORT



The City of Newburyport has had paid parking lots since May 2011. Below please find some useful information on the pay by plate kiosks, times of operations, locations, and more.

ABOUT PAID PARKING

The Parking Clerk's office manages public parking in the City of Newburyport which includes seven paid parking lots and on-street parking.

Overnight parking is not permitted in any lot. Many of the streets have time limits of 2 hours or some other time period. Please look at the signs for specific time limits.

PARKING LOT INFORMATION

- **Green St. Lot (ZONE 2150) Permits – Resident Permit Valid**
\$1.50/HR - 3HR Limit
- **State St. Lot (ZONE 2151) Permits – Resident Permit Valid**
\$1.00/HR - 3HR Limit
- **Prince Place Lot (ZONE 2152) Permits – Resident & Employee Permit Valid**
\$1.50/HR - All Day Parking (Except in designated spaces)
- **NRA East Lot (ZONE 2153) Permits – Resident & Employee Permit Valid** *\$1.00/HR - All Day Parking*
- **NRA West Lot (ZONE 2154) Permits – Resident & Employee Permit Valid** *\$1.00/HR - All Day Parking*
- **Waterfront Trust Lot (ZONE 2155) No permits valid here**
\$1.00/HR - All Day Parking
- **Hales Ct. Lot (ZONE 2156) Permits – Resident & Employee Permit Valid** *\$1.50/HR - 3HR Limit*

WHERE ARE THE PAY BY PLATE KIOSKS?

There are one or more kiosks in each parking lot. There is an easily identifiable sign "Pay Here" above each kiosk. The seven parking lots are identified on the map on the reverse side of this brochure.

HOW DO I PAY?

- At the kiosk, with cash or credit card
- By phone, through the *Passport App*, available at <http://m.ppprk.com>.

PAID PARKING HOURS

The kiosks operate Monday through Saturday from 8 am to 8 pm and Sunday from 12 pm to 6 pm.

RESIDENT AND EMPLOYEE PAID PARKING PERMITS

The parking office issues yearly discounted parking permits to residents, senior residents, and employees. The permits allow a vehicle to park in six paid parking lots (not the Waterfront Trust Lot) without paying a fee for each use – see 'parking lot information'. **Time limits DO apply to permit holders.** Your license plate serves as your permit identifier and windshield stickers are no longer issued. **These permits are not for on-street parking;** there is no fee to park on-street.

Permits are renewable annually on July 1st and can be purchased or renewed online at newburyportpermits.rmcpay.com. The following **fees** apply:

- Annual Resident Paid Parking Permit: \$15.00/vehicle, plus \$3.00 processing fee
- Annual Senior Resident Paid Parking Permit: \$5.00/vehicle (65 years of age or older)
- Annual Employee Paid Parking Permit: \$160.00/vehicle
- Quarterly Employee Paid Parking Permit: \$40.00/vehicle
- Fee for a changed license plate: \$5.00

HELPFUL TIPS

To ensure your parking experience is easy and uneventful during your visit to Newburyport, please follow the helpful tips below:

- Park lawfully. Observe time limits in the lots and on the streets. Do not park in restricted areas and always park within the lines of parking area.
- Use one of our five designated paid lots for all day parking.
- Kiosks accept coins, dollar bills, and major credit cards.
